Our Beginnings

Dr. Ernest Holmes founded the spiritual movement from which the Centers for Spiritual Living find their basis.

Born in 1887 on a small farm in Maine, Dr. Holmes spent his teenage years outdoors, asking himself:

“What is God? Who am I? Why am I here?”

This questioning led to his 1926 book, *The Science of Mind*, which outlined the foundational viewpoints of the modern New Thought Movement.
